INTERNATIONAL APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP

Bethany offers a limited number of international scholarships. Not every applicant will be granted a scholarship or financial aid from Bethany. Scholarships are granted on a one-year basis and are reevaluated at the end of the year.

Before an I-20 form is issued, all international students, including scholarship recipients, are required to submit a \$1,500 deposit to cover the cost of their return-trip ticket, medical expenses, and required textbooks. The remaining deposit will be returned to the student upon departure from Bethany.

International Scholarship Guidelines

- Scholarships are awarded to select individuals who are committed to the spread of the Gospel in their nations and who will make an impact for the Gospel in their nations.
- The scholarship recipient understands that he/she is expected to **return to his/her country upon completion** of studies at Bethany.
- International individuals who have the ability to pay their expenses, in full or in part through employment in their nation, family or friends here or abroad, personal fund raising in their country, or other means, are expected to do so.
- Scholarship students are expected to provide for their own transportation to return to their nations.
- Scholarship applicants must read, review and agree to all the stipulations listed on the *Information for International Applicants* sheet.
- Failure to comply with student or international scholarship guidelines may result in a revoking of the student's scholarship.

All scholarship applications should be completed and postmarked by February 15 prior to the beginning of the following academic school year.
